Are they real?

You are invited to an exhibition of new paintings in my studio in Hove on the Sussex Coast. The studio is within a late Victorian house and the exhibition is part of the annual Brighton and Hove Artists Open Houses. (please scroll down)...

The theme of dolls is a departure. Having moved into a Victorian house and surrounded by the wonderful antique shops of Brighton and Hove, I became interested in memorabilia of the period and was struck by the importance of dolls, their striking images, their elaborate clothing and their relevance to childhood. I started painting one, two, and then they began to multiply, including dolls that blur the distinction between real and unreal. Come and meet them in Hove. They may delight you. They may challenge you.

My previous, mainly landscape paintings, can also be seen in the house but the main exhibition of Dolls is in the studio at the top of the house.

I am a psychologist and psychotherapist but also a practicing artist, having had ten solo exhibitions in London, with work in many collections across the world. This is my first exhibition in Hove. The paintings are for sale.
